If you are 70 ½ years old or older, you can take advantage of a simple way to benefit your law school and receive tax benefits in return. You can give up to \$111,000 from your IRA directly to a qualified charity such as ours without having to pay income taxes on the distribution.

Via Check:

Contact your IRA custodian and request a distribution to be postmarked no later than December 15th (IRS regulations require that the gift be *deposited* prior to December 31st). Ask your IRA custodian to include your name on the check and send the check to:
